Review/approval of February 23rd, meeting minutes: Vince & Theresa

Report out of officers

President: Vince Loscerbo

Minimum of 36 kids on a team before you split, and you must take all registrations and no
waitlist. Not as many coaches to kids' ratio concerned for team safety. EMass discussed at last
meeting and made the rule and went into registration and changed it.

Vice President's Report: Brian Day

- Field availability
- Clinic on June 27th & 28th options are limited due to turf and construction. Grass practice field, Woodland Field and Fino Field. Community Use has a permit to use for camp 8 am - 6 pm.
- Football season High School only has 2 home games but not sure if the field will be ready for us to use. Possibly pay to have games at a different town or use Fino Field outfield. Revenue loss with concession if we can't use the High School field.
- Nipmuc and Medway struggling and unable to put a team together for any grade level. Last year they merged with Westborough. Our issues are Mighty Mites through 5th grade and possibly merge with them for younger grades. If we merge then perhaps use their fields. Only merge with the younger grades as older grades full
- Nipmuc has already engaged us to merge so makes sense to be made for longevity. Should collaborate with issues from years to come. They would need to play in our league and not vise versa. Needs to be full commitment- during covid year they pulled out for 8th grade. We didn't have a season at that time anyway, so it was okay.
- One of the few leagues that do everything appropriately to assure safety. Meeting was
 postponed till next month as poor numbers signed up. Canceled Riddell speaker that was
 going to go through safety presentation.
- Dana Olson MHS Coach certified from Heads Up through Boston University and will come in to speak regarding safety. Both Dana and Dale Olson are certified to speak and teach on safety. Riddell was going to come in with video and equipment to demonstrate.
- Would like to start the coaching meeting with HS coaches again and the teaching seminar.
- HS team coaches have an open door policy to meet.
- HS kids only practice in upper equipment all week. Limited hitting.
- Milford HS only had 1 concussion in 3 years.
- Need to connect HS and youth programs together. Need to try to merge the programs.
- Fino Field- should try to get to play games there. Get goalposts.




