Development-Courtney Lechman

- MA evaluation ice, extra for separate A evaluations (U9/U11)
 - -go over the ice schedule for U9 and U11 slots, 4 for each division-for the A Skate
 - -Will speak to Max Analytics confirming 4 ice slots needed
 - -Deadline for giving back ice is Aug.3/25 notified by Oakbank Arena
 - Arena needs to let us know what their rates are. SMHA Deadline first week of June to receive rates.
 - Will be able to set our registration rate following receiving Arenas ice costs
 - -Possibly set up by Aug.3rd/25
- Starting evals, date

- -Push U13/15 till after the AA try outs are complete (one week back)
- -Allows more flexibility at U9/U11 as well by pushing back U13/U15
- -Hockey Wpg made a rule that rural Eastman teams are not allowed into the league; Eastman thinks they are grandfathered in. This will be looked into by Mat

Rustbuster

- -Success last year, \$150 for 4 ice times. A total of 270 kids went through it.
- -Possibly spread out Rustbusters a little bit more this year
- -U15 Hitting clinics were completed in Rustbuster for 2024 Season
- -Cory Nakamura will do a hitting camp, no more than 20 kids on the ice at a time.

Possible Rust Buster contracts: Owen Blocker, Brett Davis, Matt Haubbauer, Joe West

- -Idea is to split them up into different age groups
- -Request a proposal from all vendors

• Intro, change the programming

- -Difficult to run the program with that many kids
- -kids are bypassing can skate and straight into that program
- discussing only major age kids
- -alot of associations do not offer this program
- -continuing with these numbers we may have to split up the program
- -39 kids registered in 2024/25 season
- -kids coming into U7 that can't skate
- -change it to our own can skate program and second half more of a hockey program
- -if we hired one trainer and they had assistance
- -could we possibly blend it with hockey and learning to skate?
- We can encourage families to go to canskate first for kids to learn how to skate
- -Keep same ice and arena
- Board Decision in June

Female Convenor-Laurie Turnbull

- proposal to visit elementary schools in the area to promote girls hockey at the intro level (K to gr. 3) to ensure the program continues to thrive moving forward
 - -Dugald principal is open, K-3 age groups
 - -older kids make a poster why they like hockey, creating a bit of a mentoring program
 - -We support the growth of females in the hockey program
 - -This would be done prior to the end of June 2025
 - -October Try Hockey Day, or floor hockey in August.

- proposed Goalie coaching package for coaches to use at U9 and U11 level to help with goalie development and retention
 - -Goaltender retention- Create a basic package e.g. U9 proper equipment fits, movement patterns, half ice drills.
 - -What are some things kids should try in a practice before a game
 - -Matt- will run goalie development through the regional level. This will be put together for all eastman teams.
 - -Byron put together a manual last year, asked for one bench staff to have goalie training. Including level 2 and goalie 1. Next year identify who has taken this course and share with them the information.
 - -Add to registration
 - Are you interested in goaltending

U9/U11 Convenor- Mathew Bannerman
