

## **Kennworth Park Recreation Association (KPRA) Concession Stand Volunteer Policy**

The concession stand plays an important role in supporting our softball program and helping keep registration fees affordable for families. Revenue generated through concession sales helps fund league expenses such as field maintenance, equipment purchases, umpire fees, facility improvements, and player development initiatives.

To help ensure the concession stand operates successfully throughout the season, each player registered with Kennworth Park Recreation Association is required to have a parent or legal guardian complete one (1) two-hour volunteer shift during the season.

### **Volunteer Responsibilities**

1. A parent or legal guardian must report to the concession stand at the beginning of their scheduled shift and remain for the full two-hour assignment.
2. Volunteers must sign in upon arrival so that volunteer hours can be properly recorded.
3. A KPRA Board Member or designated league representative will be available during each shift to provide guidance and answer questions.
4. Volunteer tasks may include serving food and beverages, operating the register, grilling, restocking items, cleaning, trash cleanup, or other concession-related duties as needed.
5. For safety and insurance reasons, children under the age of 16 may not work in the concession stand unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

### **Volunteer Commitment & Bond Fee**

Each registered player is subject to a \$50 volunteer bond fee. This fee will only be charged if the required concession stand volunteer obligation is not fulfilled during the season.

Families who do not complete their assigned volunteer shift by the end of the season will be charged the \$50 bond fee using the payment method provided during registration. Sponsorships, donations, or other registration credits do not satisfy or waive the volunteer requirement and will not be applied toward the bond fee.

If a family is unable to work their scheduled shift, it is their responsibility to arrange a replacement or coordinate a new shift with the league prior to the scheduled volunteer date.

### **Scheduling**

Available volunteer dates and time slots will be published via Sign-up Genius when the season schedule is released. Families will have the opportunity to select a shift from the available openings.
