



# Blue & Gold Classic

## 5th/6th Grade Tournament Rules

### POOL PLAY

- 22 Minute Games / 3 minute warmup
- Continuous clock until the last minute of the game
- Elementary Gym only, due to size, teams will have 10 seconds to get across the half line but the volleyball line will be used as the over and back line

### TOURNAMENT GAMES

- (2) 15 minute halves / 2 minute halftime / 3 minute warmup
- Continuous Clock until the last minute of first half and the last 2 minutes of the second half

### TOURNAMENT RULES

- All Games will be played using National High School Federation Rules.
- Each team is given 2 (30 second) timeouts per game.
- Overtime, 2 minutes, each team gets 1-30 second timeout (No carryover timeouts).
- Regulation foul line to be utilized. 5th grade ONLY can jump over the line.
- Double Bonus will begin on the 7th foul of the game (half for tournament games).
- All shooting fouls and double bonus fouls will be result in 1 point automatically given + 1 foul shot taken
- Personal fouls: 5 foul limit per player
- Size 28.5 balls used for both boys and girls division
- 5th grade teams can press last 4 minutes of the pool play game (each half of tournament play), provided they are not winning by 15 or more points
- 6th grade teams can press last 6 minutes of the pool play game (each half of tournament play), provided they are not winning by 15 or more points
- Official scorekeepers will be provided, please bring a roster. Players must have a number on their jersey or shirt.

### POOL PLAY TIE-BREAKERS

1. Head to Head
2. Point Differential (maximum of 15 per game)
3. Least Points Given Up
4. Coin Toss

\*In a 3 way tie, the top team is 1st place based on point differential. Once that is established, 2nd and 3rd place are determined by the head to head matchup between those two teams only (the winner becomes the 2nd place team and the loser becomes the 3rd place team)

\*If both teams have the same record and the same point differential we will use least points given up as the determining factor. If it is still tied after that, a coin toss will determine the winner
