IMPORTANT DATES:

FEES DUE on March 15th, 2026

EARLY BIRD DRAW on March 6th, 2026 - Prize is \$100 Costco Card

Fees remain at \$1,400 for returning teams

NEW teams pay \$1,500 (\$100 of which is for levy fund)

A&C Tournament - August 14-16th

B, D & E Tournament - August 21-23

Cut off date to inform league of intent to enter you division's respective tournament is July 19th. All levy funds need to be topped back up to \$100 before tournaments, should your team incur any fines

NEW RULES / ALTERNATIONS:

2.1 SPN Rosters are due **before** the start of the season.

This is to be done online at www.spn.com. All games will count as a forfeit until handed in. Team captains/managers should be entering their teams' roster on the SPN website.

***NEW: A written roster list to be handed in BEFORE
schedules are made***

NEW RULES / ALTERNATIONS:

2.6 “A” players playing in lower divisions: You may have a MAXIMUM of 3 “A” players on any of the lower division teams. These players MUST be SPN rostered on their highest division team.

IF ANY “B-E” TEAM IS CAUGHT WITH MORE THAN 3 “A” PLAYERS ON THE FIELD/ROSTER:

- ***1st Offense: Your team will be fined \$25 of your levy***
- ***2nd Offense: The player will be suspended from ALL league play, for ANY team for 2 weeks***
- ***3rd Offense: The player will be suspended for the remainder of the year, from ALL teams.***

NEW RULES / ALTERATIONS:

2.7 If your team folds for the year and wants to come back into the league in hopes of being placed in a lower division, your teams cannot have more than 6 of the original players. If your team has more than 6 of the original players, you will be placed back into the division you left.

NEW RULES / ALTERNATIONS:

3.3 If a bat is found in play (player using it in the game, in bat caddie, anywhere visual) without the sticker, the player is out, the inning is over for the batting team, **and your team will be fined \$25 from your team levy.** Please report any incidents to the league, and the discipline committee will investigate.

NEW RULES / ALTERNATIONS:

4.2 Please make sure that if you're not able to field a team for a game, **you give 4 hours minimum notice to your opponents.** Please make sure to email the league promptly as well.

5.1 The Walk Rule. **A male player is awarded second base if he is thrown four (4) balls, with any count, when a female player is on deck. The female player must take her scheduled at-bat.**

5.2 PITCHER/CATCHER COMBINATION: **If you have a female pitcher, you MUST have a male catcher. If you have a male pitcher, you MUST have a female catcher.**

NEW RULES / ALTERNATIONS:

5.4 If a batted ball hits the home plate and lands in fair territory, the ball is live/fair.

5.5 Female players are allowed to bunt in any division. Any female player who presents to bunt is then committed and must follow through with the intent, or it is considered an out. The player may pull back if the pitch thrown is a ball, but cannot switch intent to swing.

NEW RULES / ALTERNATIONS:

5.9B Should a game be cancelled due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances, there must be a reasonable effort to reschedule the game between the teams themselves or agree to the game ending in a 7-7 tie. If the team that does not wish to take a 7-7 tie, they will propose three reasonable options for makeup game dates and times. If the other team cannot make any of the three work and cannot suggest another suitable option, they will take a 0-7 forfeit. **These games can be rescheduled during one of the holiday weeks (April 5-11, May 17-23, June 28-July 4, August 2-8) *Please reach out to the league with the decision that is made, so we can book fields.**

NEW RULES / ALTERNATIONS:

5.17 PINCH RUNNER: the batter has to make it to first base before using a pinch runner. Teams are allowed 3 pinch runners per game. This player can only run once per game, and has to be an active player in the line-up.

5.18 SUBSTITUTIONS: Players **MUST** field first. Substituting players can be written at the bottom of the order if it is not known at the beginning of the game, who that person will be substituting for.

5.19 RE-ENTRY: Players are allowed 1 re-entry. Once this player has been entered into the game, they cannot be entered in for any other player. After this, the player is no longer eligible to be entered into the game for anyone else, at any time.

5.20 Mercy Rule is 15 runs after 5 completed innings, **or 10 runs after 6 completed innings.**

MANDATORY UMPING CLINIC:

At least one representative from each team must be present. Levy fine will be \$75 for non attendance. Attendees can not sign up for more than one team.
