The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to establish a consistent expectation for parent's/athlete behavior and commitments while they are members of the North Bay Blaze. This applies to behavior both during practices and tournaments.

- Respect and courtesy will be shown to all members including coaches, umpires, athletes & parents. Good sportsmanship will be demonstrated at all practices and tournaments by being supportive towards all athletes in all groups/teams.
- I understand that the bleachers are for parents and spectators to support their athletes' activities. **Using the bleachers to publicly criticize the coaches, umpires, other parents, other children or other programs is forbidden.** This will be strictly enforced.
- If conflicts arise, please request to meet with the Head Coach at a mutually convenient time to discuss solutions. Please contact the Select Executive if solutions are not found.
- All players must attend house league games and practices. If failure to do so, suspension or removal of the select team will be considered.
- All players must play in their respective age category unless otherwise requested by the organization.
- All select practices are mandatory unless the athlete has been excused by the coach in advance.
- If in violation of this Code of Conduct, the athlete, and/or parent, will be subject to disciplinary action which could result in suspensions or removal from the team without refund.
