



Exceptional Player Form

U7 to U9 – Not permitted, although U7 players may affiliate with U9 teams in accordance with PA Hockey player affiliation guidelines.

U9 to U11 - Not permitted, although U9 players may affiliate with U11 teams in accordance with PA Hockey player affiliation guidelines.

Under 11 to Under 13 AA

Second year Under 11 players/goaltenders, may be advanced to Under 13 AA tryouts through the following procedure.

- 1) A request for concession must be submitted in writing to Prince Albert Hockey.
- 2) The request for concession must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$300.00 fee. Deadline to apply is January 10th of the current year (so for the 2026-2027 season you need to apply by January 2026).
- 3) The player in question must have played Under 11 Division the previous season.

If these guidelines are met, then the request for concession will be dealt with by the Board on a case-by-case basis.

It should be understood that any Under 11 aged player to be able to make the AA team must evaluate as: Top 3 Forwards, Top 2 Defense, Goaltender must rank as the top goaltender.

Under 13 to Under 15 AA

Second year Under 13 players/goaltenders, may be advanced to Under 15 AA tryouts through the following procedure.

- 1) A request for concession must be submitted in writing to Prince Albert Hockey.
- 4) The request for concession must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$300.00 fee. Deadline to apply is January 10th of the current year (so for the 2026-2027 season you need to apply by January 2026).
- 2) The player in question must have played Under 13 Division the previous season.

If these guidelines are met, then the request for concession will be dealt with by the Board on a case by case basis.

It should be understood that the Under 13 aged player to be able to make the Under 15 AA team must evaluate as: Top 3 Forwards, Top 2 Defense, Goaltender must rank as the top goaltender.

***Special Note**

Player will be evaluated by a board approved evaluator along with others during tryout evaluations. Exceptions may be considered by the PA Hockey Board for applications.
