



Release Policy

The PAH Release Policy has the mandate to keep as many players as possible in our association while offering players an opportunity to reach higher levels.

The PAH Board may approve and grant player releases under PA Hockey and Hockey Sask guidelines.

All release requests must be submitted to the office prior to August 1.

The Board will review, vote on and grant the release outside the guidelines only for a valid reason (i.e., personal hardship).

Release Guidelines for U7, U9, and U11

Player releases typically will only be granted where there is no team available in the home center.

Release Guidelines for U13, U15, U18

Player releases may be granted for a player qualifying for a non-PA Hockey AA team only if the player has tried out and has not been selected for the PA Hockey AA team.

Subject to item above, player releases may only be granted as long as there remain enough players to constitute a team or teams in the home center, excluding the player requesting the release.

Written confirmation of acceptance to non-PA Hockey team (excluding AA) must be provided for release to be considered.

Player releases to a non-AA team will only be granted where there is no team available for that player within PA Hockey.

A player release is only good for the current hockey season.

Release requests need to be applied for each hockey season.

Release Guidelines for Female Players

Player releases will be granted for female players to play on an all-female team, where PA Hockey cannot provide a female team to play on; above guidelines will be followed otherwise

Appeals

A player whose release request has been denied by PA Hockey may appeal to Hockey Sask as per Hockey Sask guidelines.
