



# South Grenville Minor Hockey Association Policies

## SGMHA Team Selection Policy

South Grenville Minor Hockey Association will provide two evaluators, as well as a dedicated goalie evaluator. The head coach may also appoint one evaluator, who must meet the following criteria: they must not have a child participating in the tryouts, must not be related to any participant, and must possess relevant hockey knowledge.

The team selection will be based on evaluations. The head coach may select the final three players, provided each is within 5 evaluation points of the fourth-lowest scored player.

## SGMHA Injured Player During Tryouts Policy

South Grenville Minor Hockey Association permits reserving a spot on a team for injured players. It is at the coach's discretion to reserve a spot for an injured player during the tryout process. This decision should be based on the player's past performance and experience in previous seasons. Any such decision must be communicated to all participants prior to the first tryout. A doctor's note must be submitted to our Director of Hockey Development for approval prior to the decision being made.

## SGMHA Import Player Policy

South Grenville Minor Hockey Association permits import players to participate in the tryout process. This helps ensure our teams remain competitive with other Rep B teams in our league. To be considered, an import player must rank in the top 10. We will allow up to 3 imports per team maximum. This could be up for an executive vote depending on the numbers in the division as a whole. **Imports are only permitted to tryout if : 1 – They have been released from their own association's rep tryout. Or 2 – Their home association does not have a rep team in their level.**

## SGMHA Bench Staff Selection Policy

All bench staff must be approved by the South Grenville Minor Hockey Association Rules and Discipline Committee.

**Selection of bench staff is to occur only after tryouts are completed.** Once selected, the bench staff list must be emailed to the SGMHA Registrar, who will forward it to the Rules and Discipline Committee for approval.

## SGMHA Jersey Policy

All SGMHA jerseys must be kept in the care of team parents—players are **not** permitted to take jerseys home. One or two designated parents should be responsible for managing the jerseys, collecting them after each home and away game, and ensuring they are washed and dried as needed.

Use of any SGMHA uniform or equipment for activities outside of SGMHA is strictly prohibited unless prior approval is obtained from the Equipment Manager. Failure to comply may result in disciplinary action.
