Code of Ethics (Parents)

Parents play a critical role in the overall experience in any soccer program. They are a primary resource for the player to process and understand what is happening before and after practices and games. A parent's encouragement to all children creates a positive environment where a love of the game can flourish. Any violation of this code of conduct may result in disciplinary action from PYSC, Bay-Lakes, or SAY.

The following CODE OF ETHICS AND BEHAVIOR is offered here to exemplify the ideal PYSC, Bay-Lakes, and SAY Soccer Parent.

I WILL:

- Prioritize the well-being of all players above winning a game.
- Understand and know the rules of the game.
- Ensure that my kid(s) are prepared for practices and games.
- Treat the referee with respect, no matter what the call is. Allow for honest mistakes.
- Value the opinions of my kid(s) coaches.
- Advocate for my kid(s) in a positive, responsible, and appropriate manner.
- Set an example of good sportsmanship. Treat others how you would like to be treated.
- Understand reporting obligations. Report and suspected child abuse to the center for Safesport and local law enforcement.
- Refrain from using drugs, alcohol, and tobacco products at all youth soccer events.
- Not force my child to participate in practices or events.
- Not use derogatory, discriminatory, or profane language at PYSC, Bay-Lakes, or SAY Soccer events.
- Not use social media in a way that is harmful to others.
