

2020-21 U11 Hybrid Goalie Program

For the 2020-21 season the Hybrid Goalie Program will be implemented city wide, and will be open to both first and second year players. This is not a continuation of the goalie rotations experienced in Novice and goalies are expected to provide all of their own equipment after the completion of evaluations.

To participate in this program the participant's family must agree to playing and practicing both positions equally throughout the year. Players will not be able to withdraw from the program part way through and registration fees will not be refunded.

To qualify, the participant must evaluate as both a goalie and a player and at the end of evaluations be ranked within one cohort for both positions. This is to ensure as fair a result as possible for the participant, their teammates, coaches and opposition. Any participant who is deemed to have reduced their effort in either evaluation process in an attempt to ensure they qualify for the program will be disqualified.

The participant will be evaluated as a goalie during two (2) "Goalie Only" skills sessions, and then must attend all of the player skills sessions as a player.

Participants wishing to register as full-time goalies for the 2020-21 season may continue to do so but should be aware they may be placed on a team with a participant who is a hybrid goalie/player.

The results of evaluations will not be known until near the end of the process. If a participant is trending toward not qualifying (evaluating greater than one division away from each position) they will be notified and asked to commit to being a full-time player or a full-time goalie for the upcoming season and will be expected to participate in the remaining evaluation sessions for the position of their choice.
