- Oct 12 – deadline to request an in-town Season Break tournament (Nov 17 – 30)
- Oct 18 – Seeding Round Begins
- Nov 10 – deadline to request schedule windows to attend tournaments during the regular season
- Nov 12 - deadline to request an in-town Winter Break tournament (Dec 22 - Jan 1)
- Nov 15 – Provincial Tournament host bids deadline
- Nov 16 – Seeding Round ends

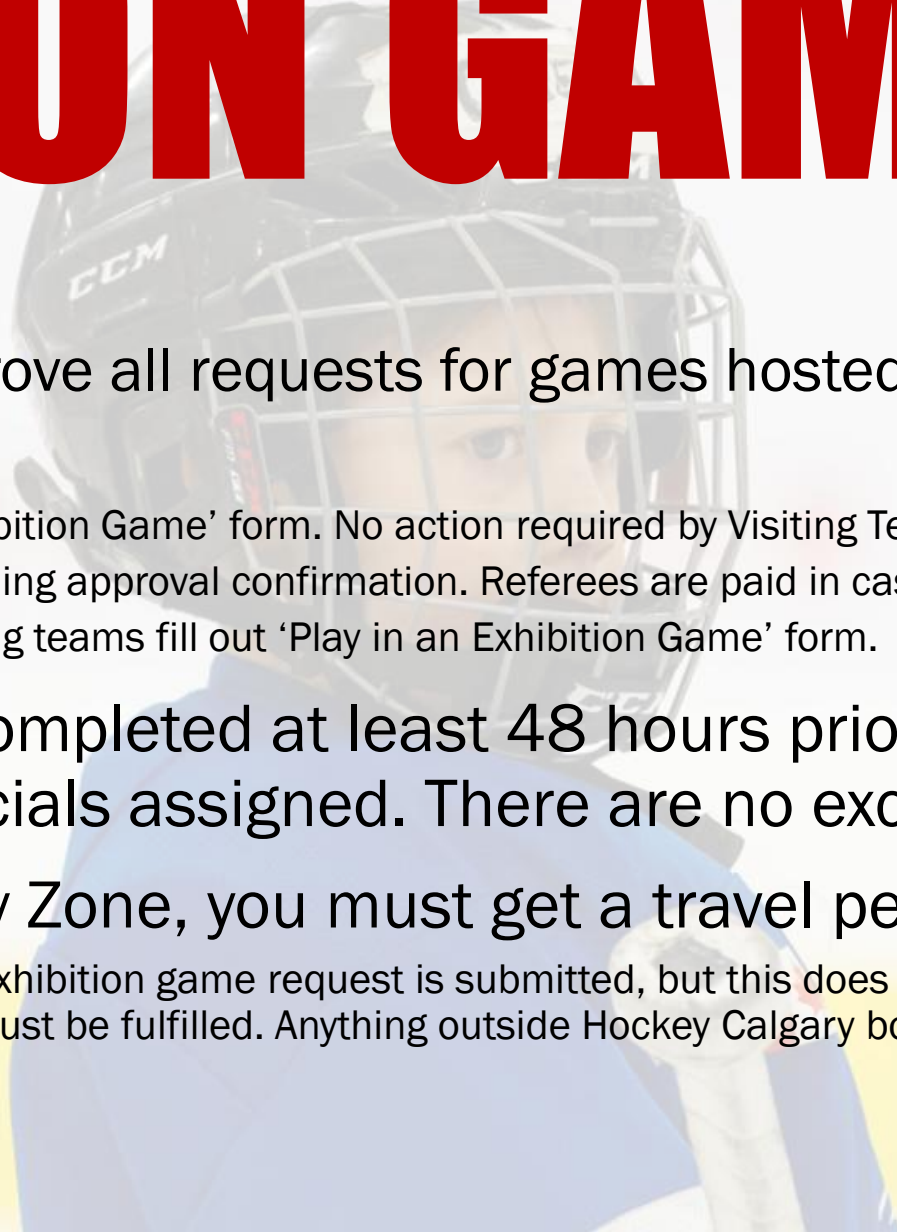
- 45 Game Max
 - 6 Seeding Round games
 - 12 Regular Season games
 - EMHW (1st game – Also a Regular Season Game)
 - Exhibition Games
 - Tournament Games
 - EMHW (except game 1), Playoffs, and Provincial games DO NOT count
- 4 Tournament Max (excluding EMHW)
 - Maximum 2 of the 4 can be 'out of town'
 - NOTE: Tournament maximums may be exceeded with the written approval of your Member Club.

GAMEPLAY GUIDELINES

- Jersey Colours – Home team will wear **DARK JERSEYS**
- Off-ice Volunteers
 - Each team must supply 2 off-ice officials for all games. The Home Team will be responsible for the Timekeeper and Home Penalty box; the Visiting team will be responsible for the Scorekeeper and Visitor Penalty box.
- Handshakes are permitted but Hockey Calgary strongly recommends the ‘fist bump’



EXHIBITION GAMES



- Permit/sanction # is required.
- Exhibition Games – League Chairs approve all requests for games hosted outside Calgary
 - Game in Calgary? Home team fills out 'Play in an Exhibition Game' form. No action required by Visiting Team. Central Region approves game by assigning officials and sending approval confirmation. Referees are paid in cash at the game.
 - Game outside Calgary? All Hockey Calgary participating teams fill out 'Play in an Exhibition Game' form.
- Exhibition game requests must be completed at least 48 hours prior to the start of the game in order to get officials assigned. There are no exceptions.
- If you are playing outside the Calgary Zone, you must get a travel permit.
 - Travel permits are automatically generated when an exhibition game request is submitted, but this does not mean the team has a schedule window. All league obligations must be fulfilled. Anything outside Hockey Calgary boundaries requires a travel permit

TOURNAMENT AND TRAVEL PERMITS

- All teams participating in a tournament must complete a “Play in Tournament” form on their Hockey Calgary dashboard.
- If the tournament is out of town, a travel permit is required
 - Travel permits are automatically generated when a Play in a Tournament form is submitted, but this does not mean the team has a schedule window. All league obligations must be fulfilled. A schedule window is required to ensure a team is not scheduled for a league game.

TOURNAMENT AND TRAVEL PERMITS

- **U11 FEMALE** Teams are permitted **1 COMPLIMENTARY SCHEDULE WINDOW DURING THE SEEDING ROUND AND 1 ADDITIONAL SCHEDULE WINDOW FOR A \$200 FEE DURING THE REGULAR SEASON.**
- **U11 COED** Teams are permitted **1 COMPLIMENTARY SCHEDULE WINDOW DURING REGULAR SEASON, AND 1 ADDITIONAL SCHEDULE WINDOW FOR A \$200 FEE DURING THE REGULAR SEASON.**
 - Schedule windows are not permitted during the seeding round. This applies to all coed Community Leagues including U11AA.
- Tournaments are not allowed during EMHW or Adrenalin City Championships



'OUT OF TOWN'

- Hockey Calgary has adjusted its definition of what rinks count towards the total number of Out-of-Town tournaments. Teams are still required to request a travel permit as well as tournament coordinators still need to source referees for tournaments. Hockey Calgary only assigns officials for tournaments within the Calgary Zone.
- The following rinks will no longer count toward the 'Out-of-Town' tournament total and will be considered 'In Town' tournaments

GAME RESCHEDULES

In an effort to provide more flexibility, Hockey Calgary has implemented a Game Reschedule Policy for the 2025-2026 season that will allow teams to reschedule a Seeding or Regular Season game for a \$150 fee. A portion of this fee will be donated to the Flames Even Strength Program.

- Note: Teams must meet the requirements outlined in the policy
- Games that are originally scheduled from October 31 and onwards may be rescheduled. Games that are originally scheduled prior to and including October 30 cannot be rescheduled. There will be no exceptions.

NOTE – Please do not commit to a tournament if you have not received confirmation from Hockey Calgary that your scheduled league game has been rescheduled

HOCKEY CALGARY WEBSITE

- Team Managers will use their Hockey Calgary login for the website to manage the following:
 - Requesting exhibition games and entering the scoresheet information into the website
 - Requesting schedule windows to attend tournaments
 - Requesting game reschedule
 - Entering in tournament scoresheets into travel permits
 - Esso Minor Hockey Week games and entering scoresheets
 - Adrenalin City Championship games and entering scoresheets
 - Special Event Permits

RAMP ONLINE SCORESHEETS

- All Seeding Round and Regular Season league games will be using online scoresheets through the RAMP portal.
- All exhibition games and tournament games will be scored using paper scoresheets.
- Please download the RAMP Gamesheet APP onto your phone.
- Team Managers will each need to create a profile on the RAMP website <http://hockeycalgary.msa4.rampinteractive.com/> (Scroll down to Admin Login)
- This initial profile allows you to then add multiple logins under that profile. For example, you could have a Hockey Calgary login as well as a soccer or baseball login.
- Once you set up the initial profile you can log in using the credentials you received from Hockey Calgary under “Add App Access” and selecting RAMP Websites. Both the Hockey Calgary login and the RAMP login were initially created using the same login and password for both.
- The systems are not linked so if you have updated one of the logins it will not automatically update the second login.

RAMP ONLINE SCORESHEETS

- You will be able to view your Team Code to enter into the App to have all of your games populate to the App.
- You will be able to view your gamesheet codes for each of your games.
- Team Managers will need to use the “Home and Visitor Codes” to check in their teams.
- Scorekeepers will need to use the “Gamesheet Code” to scorekeep the game.
- Officials will need to use the “Official Code” to add their names to the gamesheet, fill out any incident reports and sign off the game.

AFFILIATE PLAYERS

- Affiliated players may be used in place of players registered on a team to a maximum of 10 games
 - League, Playoff, and Provincial games
- Affiliates are NOT to be used until they are approved by Hockey Calgary. League Chairs will notify teams when they have approved affiliates. This WILL NOT occur prior to the start of Seeding Round.
- Coaches do not get to select their affiliate players. The Member Club is tasked with selecting affiliates and communicating to teams when they can access their affiliates.
- Affiliate players cannot be used for suspended players.

CONFLICT RESOLUTION

- It's our favorite rule, all parties involved should take the 24-hour rule.
- Collect factual, not emotional information of the situation.
- Collect information from both sides.
- Must be impartial, always better to walk away. Most things are better dealt with the next day.
- REMEMBER - your referees are just kids, they are learning as well. Abuse will not be tolerated.
- Complaints regarding referees are to be sent through your Member Club following the proper community channels within your Member Club.
- Use your League Chairs and Governors.

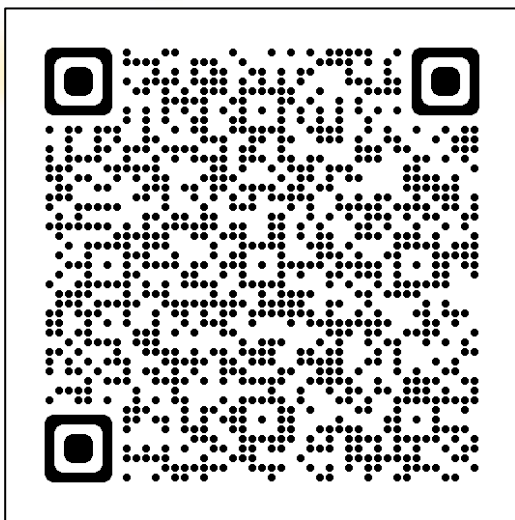

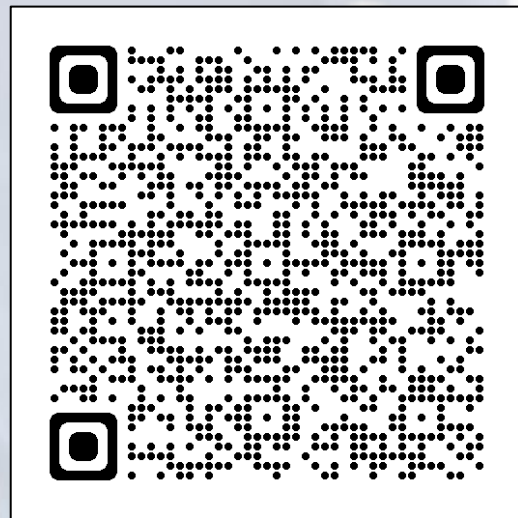
