RHC is seeking a detail-oriented and organized **Equipment Manager** to oversee the distribution, maintenance, and inventory of RHC owned equipment. This role is essential in ensuring teams are properly outfitted throughout the season and that equipment is maintained to a high standard year over year.

Key Responsibilities

As **Equipment Manager**, you will:

Pre-Season (September)

- Distribute equipment to Head Coaches prior to the start of the season.
- Maintain an accurate and up-to-date inventory of all distributed equipment.

Post-Season (April–June)

- Coordinate the return, cleaning, repair, and storage of jerseys and all RHC-owned equipment.
- Gather feedback from Age Group Coordinators and the Player Development Coordinator on:
 - Equipment condition
 - Sizing and fit
 - Needs for new or replacement equipment
- Order and maintain inventory of required equipment for the upcoming season.
