Position Overview: Referee Liaison

You will keep the Board informed and work with the Central Zone Referee Committee on matters requiring further attention. This role promotes clear communication and strong alignment across coaches, officials, and the organization.

Key Responsibilities

As **Referee Liaison**, you will:

- Attend Central Zone Referee Committee (CZRC) and RHC meetings as required.
- Review and assess complaints concerning officials and players.
- Communicate with the Central Zone Referee Committee or appropriate RHC representatives regarding complaints deemed to have merit.
