

Basketball Rules (K-1/2nd-3rd)

Basket Height:

- K-1 Divisions will use 8 feet
- 2nd- 3rd grade Division will use 9 feet

Players:

• 5 on 5 for all divisions

Scoring:

• No score is kept for kindergarten through 3rd grade divisions except for the final March Madness games. Scores will be kept for all games in the 4th through 6th grade division.

Game Length:

- Running clock four 8 minute quarters with a 2 minute halftime.
- Clock stops on all dead balls the last 2 minutes of the game for 4th 6th grade division if the game is within 10 points.

Timeouts:

• 1 per quarter for each team. We normally call a timeout at the 4:00 minute mark of each quarter to allow for substitutions.

Game Rules:

- No pressing in any division.
- No swatting at the ball when it is in a player's hands for $k 3^{rd}$ divisions.
- No stealing the dribble in the $k-2^{nd}$ grade divisions.
- Coaches will be allowed on the court in the $k-2^{nd}$ grade divisions.
- Zone defenses are prohibited. Teams may only use a man-to-man defense.
- All fouls will be played out of bounds in the $k-2^{nd}$ divisions. Free
- throws will be shot during shooting fouls in all other divisions.
- As this is an introductory league and a learning experience, leniency on 3 seconds, traveling, and double dribbling in the $k-3^{rd}$ grade divisions will be granted. Our referees will try to teach and instruct while officiating.

This league is designed for all participating to have a fun time. This league is strictly recreational and an introduction to positive fitness.

Emphasis is placed on enjoyment rather than winning. We want an atmosphere that creates an enjoyable childhood memory!!

Good sportsmanship is a strict requirement!
