Trainer Course:

Starting in July of 2024, HEO has moved from the HTO (Hockey Trainers of Ontario) course, to the Hockey Canada Safety Course for their Level 1 Trainer qualification. Level 1 Trainers who are currently qualified under the HTO are eligible until their HTO qualification expires. All new trainers are required to take the new Hockey Canada Safety course

Coaching Clinics

For the 2025-26 season all clinics will be conducted by HEO Instructors through the MHA. The MHA is responsible for booking the classroom and ice time, at their own expense. Refreshments etc.. for the coaches are at the MHA's discretion. Clinic criteria/information is as follows:

Coach 1 and Coach 2:

- > Hockey Canada has re vamped the online portion of the Coach 1 and Coach 2 clinics.
- > They have removed the HU Online coach $\frac{1}{2}$ and replaced it with the following:
 - Coach 1: for coaches coaching U7 and U9 Hockey Canada Coach 1 Hockey Canada Coach 1 – U7 (module specifically for coaches coaching U7) Hockey Canada Coach 1 – U9 (module specifically for coaches coaching U9)
 - Coach 2: Hockey Canada Coach 2 for coaches coaching U11, and U13-18 Recreational Hockey Canada Coach 2 - U11 (module specifically for coaches coaching U11) Hockey Canada Coach 2 – U13 (module specifically for coaches coaching U13) Hockey Canada Coach 2 – U15/18 (module specifically for coaches coaching U15)
 - Coaches are required to complete the age module for the level they are coaching.
 For example:
 - A new U7 coach must complete the following: Hockey Canada Coach 1 Hockey Canada Coach 1 – U7 (module specifically for coaches coaching U7) In Person Clinic: Coach 1 : Intro to Coach

** Coaches who have previously taken the HU Online Coach ½ and or a Coach 1 or Coach 2 (in person) clinic do not need to take the new Online clinic (s). They are required to take the clinic appropriate for their age and level moving forward

** Hockey Canada Coach 1 and 2 online clinics are offered in both English and French. Please make sure your coaches chose the appropriate language course for them.

In Person Clinic Portion

Coach 1:

- The clinic will consist of 3.5 hours of Class time and 1.5 hours of ice time. Class time must come before the Ice time. We ask for ice time just after lunch
- > Cost of the clinic is \$110 plus tax per person.
- Clinics are to be run during the day (Saturday or Sunday). Clinics can run: 8am-1pm or 9am-2pm (including a 30 minute break for coaches to get ready for the ice and have a snack)

Coach 2:

- The clinic will consist of 4.5 hours of Class time and 1.5 hours of ice time. Class time must come before the Ice time. We ask for ice time just after lunch
- > Cost of the clinic is \$110 plus tax per person.
- Clinics are to be run during the day (Saturday or Sunday). Clinics can run: 8am-2:30pm or 9am-3:30pm (including a 30 minute break for coaches to get ready for the ice and have a snack)

New Development 1 Clinic

Development 1 eLearning (LMS) Clinic

- Hockey Canada has re vamped the Development 1 clinic
- The Development 1 clinic will now consist of an Online eLearning (LMS) Portion, and a 1 day In Class portion.
- The Online eLearning Portion is a mandatory pre requisite clinic that must be taken before a coach can register for the In Class Portion of the clinic. The eLearning portion can be taken at any time
