### PARENT / GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

Youth sports are supposed to be fun for our children! Actions by parents, fans, and coaches, whether verbal or nonverbal can have a lasting emotional effect on children. Too many of today's youth and volunteers are leaving youth sport activities because of the fun being unfairly taken away by adults. Reminder, **THIS IS A KID'S SPORT, NOT FOR ADULTS**. The Warriors program strongly believes the essential elements of character building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship, trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship. As a parent or guardian of the player in the Warriors organization, your actions not only reflect on you, but your child and the entire organization.

With this being said **we have a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY!!** As a parent of the Rancho Cucamonga Warriors organization, you agree to abide by a and follow the rules and guidelines below: **Please initial and sign below BEFORE signing up your child.**

\_\_\_\_\_ I will adhere to the Rancho Warriors ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY. I will never be under the influence of or in possession of drugs, alcohol, or weapons of any kind at practices, games, trips, and any Warrior Event.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that the use of foul language towards ANYONE (coaches, teammates, officials, opponents, or spectators) will not be tolerated! I will not engage in any language or actions with intent to initiate, hurt, intimidate, or humiliate any player, coach, official or spectator. These acts shall be considered harassment and will result in the immediate removal from practice, games, or events.

\_\_\_\_\_ I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent taunting, intimidating or using foul language or gestures. I will maintain self-control at games, practices, and any other club event.

\_\_\_\_\_ Any misconduct by myself or my guest's that will risk the Warrior organization from using school facilities will result in my and or my guest's removal from the facility and suspended along with your child from the Warriors organization.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will not complain or become confrontational about penalties, or calls made by the officials, and I will respect the referees and their decisions at all times.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will support the coaches and allow them to do their jobs by not coaching my child or other players during games and practices. I will not openly question or confront coaches during, before or after a game or practice. I will take time to speak with the coaches about my concerns calmly, privately and at an agreed time and place.

\_\_\_\_\_ If there are more than 2 teams in one division, the coaches will decide on which team your child is placed on according to their skill level, there will be no exceptions for friends and family playing together, this is not open for discussion.

\_\_\_\_\_ Player numbers: Returning players will have first preference on uniform numbers, after that, the coaches will decide on numbers. We will try to accommodate all the number requests, however there is no guarantee.

**I realize that if I violate this Code of Conduct, I may be subject to disciplinary action that could include one or more, but not limited to the following:**

- Verbal Warning
- Suspension / Removal from the Warriors organization, this includes the players being removed also.
