

MJMH Policy #200: Registration

Updated: August, 2025

1. PURPOSE

This policy outlines the eligibility, registration procedures, fee structure, and refund guidelines for participation in Moose Jaw Minor Hockey Association (MJMHA) programs. It ensures that registration is conducted fairly, in compliance with Hockey Saskatchewan (Hockey Sask) regulations, and supports equitable access to minor hockey opportunities in Moose Jaw.

2. **GUIDELINES**

2.1.	Registration Eligibility		
	☐ For the purposes of Hockey Sask registration, MJMHA is categorized as a		
	AA open centre.		
	 No player may participate in Association activities unless properly registered with MJMHA. 		
	Players may register in the MJMHA program—excluding Moose Jaw AAA U18, AA		
	U18, AA U16, AA U15, and U13 AA—only if they are:		
	☐ A bonafide resident of the MJMHA hockey centre, as defined by Hockey Sask regulations. Proof of residency may be required.		
	☐ A player forced to attend school in Moose Jaw, or whose parents'		
	principal residence is in a community that has no school or hockey program.		
	☐ A player who attends school in Moose Jaw but whose parents' principal residence is in a community with an active hockey program, may register only with Board and Hockey Sask permission (Hockey Sask concession).		
	Registration for U18AAA, U18AA, U16AA, U15AA, and U13AA will follow Hockey		
	Sask Registration Procedures.		
2.2.	Registration Fees & Deadlines		
	☐ Fees and registration dates shall be set annually by the Board of Directors		
	☐ AA Head Coaches must submit finalized team rosters to the Tier Director

	Family Discount: A \$400 discount will apply for each family's third (or

	Early Bird Deadline: July 31st.
	 Rates increase by \$100 on August 1st.
	New Residents after August 1st shall receive the Early Bird rate pro-rated:
	Prior to November 1st: 100%
	 November 1st – December 31st: 75%
	 January 1st – Hockey Sask deadline: 50%
	Players waiting for a Hockey Canada transfer or a release from their home
	association will receive the early bird rate.
	Late registrants may not participate in games until confirmation of Hockey
	Sask insurance by the Registrar.

	The MJMHA Office and/or Board may suspend players until
	payment obligations are met.

Prior to first ice time	100%
After team placement and before Nov 15	75%
Nov 16 – Dec 15	50%
Dec 16 – Jan 10	25%
After Jan 10	No refund

☐ Medical refunds will be assessed on a case-by-case basis by the Board and must be accompanied by a doctor's letter.

☐ First-year skaters are eligible for a full refund until November 15th, less a \$50 administrative fee.

5. POLICY REVIEW

This policy shall be reviewed annually or as required due to updates in Hockey Sask regulations, MJMHA operational needs, or provincial legislation. Amendments must be approved by the MJMHA Board of Directors.
