

Confederation Park Little League Volunteer Information

Confederation Park Little League relies heavily on all of its members to ensure a successful baseball season for the players. Volunteers are essential to maintaining and growing the Confederation Park Little League Club. The more volunteers we have the better our league becomes. As such, we have implemented a few changes to our volunteering system to ensure we aren't leaning too heavily on our most generous members.

The Club requires each family to complete four points. You are responsible to ensure you secure enough points during the season to meet your commitment. Communicating with your team manager and our volunteer coordinator (Alicia, volunteer@confedbaseball.org) helps ensure your volunteer points are tracked for the season. We understand that circumstances change, which can influence your commitment. Families can volunteer as much as they like - thank you for your support! Please note volunteer hours/points do not carry over to the following year.

T-Ball, Rookie, Minors, Majors, Juniors, and Seniors Divisions - 4 Points

During the registration process you will see a selection of volunteer options. You will also agree to a \$200 bond during registration, which will only be charged should you not complete your volunteer commitment. There is also an option to buy-out your volunteer commitment by paying an additional \$200 during registration.

If you have other ideas or suggestions for Volunteering, please share them. The Confederation Park Board may be able to add them to our list of volunteer opportunities.

Volunteer Position	Position Description
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Coach (4 Points)	Responsible for overall team operations. Plans and organizes all practices and games. Ensures players are coached in baseball skills, systems, and team play. Assigns parent volunteers for various roles. Must submit a coach registration via the registration website.
Assistant Coach (4 Points)	Assists the Head Coach in training, coaching, and player development. Supports the Head Coach's decisions on positions and development. Must submit a coach registration via the registration website.
Team Manager (4 Points)	Handles administrative duties: Parent/Coach liaison, ensuring volunteers are in place, supporting communication. Responsible for reporting scores and pitch counts to the division director and tracking parent volunteers.

Night Coordinator (4 Points) (T-Ball only)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pick up the jerseys/hats for the 3 teams on your practice night and distribute on Opening Day. • Pick up the team photos for the 3 teams on your practice night and distribute at a game/practice. • Pick up year-end grab bags for the 3 teams on your night and distributing at a game/practice
Bench Manager (1 Point per Game) (T-Ball only)	<p>Bench managers will help to establish and manage the batting order to ensure all children are participating equally. In addition, you'll help to prioritize safety on the bench (bats against the fence and not in hands) and to keep things running smoothly, allowing Coaches to focus on the players on the field.</p>
Practice/Game Helper (1 Point per Game) (T-ball & Rookie only)	<p>Assists the coach when needed—on the field or on the bench as needed.</p>
Cancellation Coordinator (4 Points) (T-Ball & Rookie only)	<p>This individual is responsible for monitoring air quality and weather conditions using provincial AQHI data and City of Edmonton resources to determine if games or practices need to be canceled, in accordance with Little League Alberta safety guidelines and in coordination with our board representative. TeamLinkt will be utilized to send cancellation notifications to families, ensuring clear and timely communication.</p>
Indoor Practice Sign in (1 Point per shift) (Rookies & Up)	<p>Sign in players at the beginning of indoor camps/practices. Because players sign in 15 minutes before camp starts, you can sign in the next group too (if available).</p>
Score Keeping (1 Point per Game) (Minors & Up)	<p>Records outs, hits, runners, and runs scored. Tracks batting order. Records substitutions for both teams. Must attend all games signed up for. (Training April 11, 2026 at indoor practice, information to follow).</p>
Pitch Count (1 Point per Game) (Minors & Up)	<p>Accurately tracks every pitch thrown by both teams. Records count on pitch sheets and reports to Team Manager. (Training April 11, 2026 at indoor practice, information to follow).</p>

Challenger Buddy (2 Points per session)	Assists Challenger division players during practices/games. Adapts baseball skills (under the direction of the coaches) to meet the needs of assigned Challenger Athletes to ensure participation, enjoyment and success.
Team Bottle Recycle Coordinator (4 Points)	Manages bottle recycling program for the team.
Comedy Night Volunteer (4 Points)	Assists at Comedy Night (seating, raffle sales).
Comedy Night Tickets Sales (4 Points)	Must sell 6 Comedy Night tickets to earn points.
Field Clean Up (2 Points/Person)	Helps clean and maintain fields on designated clean up days.
Tournament Help (2 Points per Shift)	Assists with tournament operations for scheduled shifts. Information to follow closer to the dates.
Opening Day (2 Points per Shift)	Supports Opening Day activities and operations.
Casino (TBD) (4 Points)	Volunteer role for casino fundraising. Date to be determined; will be quarter 3 (July, August, or September).
Confederation 50-50 Raffle (4 Points)	Earns 4 points for raffle sales exceeding \$400.
Bottle recycling (4 Points)	Return a minimum of \$200 in bottle returns to the Windermere bottle depot (donate return value to Confederation Park Little at the cashier and submit receipts to your team manager).
Jersey Parent (2 Points) (Minors and Up)	Collects all jerseys at season end. Washes, dries, folds, and returns them to the division director.
