School Teams

(Middle School and High School only) **CURRENTLY REGISTERING PLAYERS**

- > Games are played against area public and private school teams
- All games are held within 45 miles of St. Charles (local)
- > Start time for games is 4:00-6:00 p.m.
- Season is March-May
- > 2-3 games per week
- Training begins in January
- 2-3 practices/training sessions per week
- > Fees are \$300 for Middle School and \$450 for High School
- Uniforms required (jersey, hat, helmet, black pants, royal blue belt, socks, molded cleats.) Minimum cost: \$120
- High School:
 12-20 games
 8-12 games

JV team (ages 13-18) Mixed grades 6-8 (ages 11-14)

Spring/Summer League Teams (14U and younger) Contingent upon interest level

- Games are played within a local league, such as St. Peters Athletic Association (SPAA) or Chesterfield Baseball & Softball Association (CBSA)
- All games are held at league fields (all local to the league—St. Peters for SPAA or Chesterfield Sports Complex for CBSA)
- > Season is April-June
- Uniforms—same as school teams (listed above)

(up to \$621 if additional uniform items purchased)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What are the fee amounts and when are the fees due?

Uniform fee: \$120 minimum M.S. Team fees: \$300 H.S. Team fees: \$450

November 30th: Uniform Fees + \$100 Deposit Due

February 1st: Remaining Fee Balance Due

Are there options for financial assistance to reduce and/or cover the fees? (Fundraisers, payment plans, donations, etc.)

YES!! We will have fundraisers and we will work with your family in any way we can to help your player(s) participate in our teams. Our first fundraiser is planned for mid-January 2026.

Can I register, pay fees, and make donations online?

Registration forms can be submitted in person or via email. Donations and fees can be paid online using Zelle or a PayPal payment/donation option through our website.

Do I have to purchase socks?

The players are required to wear black socks for games. If they wear full-length baseball pants, solid black crew-length athletic socks will be acceptable for games. Royal blue baseball socks must be worn by players who choose knee-length pants. These can be purchased through our organization or on your own.

How often will the team practice?

School teams: 2-3 times per week

Where will practices be held?

We cannot book practice fields until January 1st. The goal is to train and practice in St. Charles County.

How many games per week? How many for the season?

School Teams: 2-3 games per week, M.S. season: 8-12 games, H.S. season: 12-20 games

Is this a nonprofit organization?

Coach Code of Conduct for St. Louis Lightning Sports

As a coach for the Lightning Sports Organization, I pledge to lead by example and uphold the same core values of Respect, Responsibility, and Sportsmanship that our players and parents commit to. My actions will reinforce the standards we ask of our athletes and families, creating a unified culture of excellence.

- 1. **Respect for All:** I will treat every player, parent, official, opponent, and fellow coach with dignity and courtesy, using the same positive language and tone I expect from players and parents.
- 2. **Player-First Mentality:** I will prioritize each athlete's long-term development, confidence, and love for the game over short-term results. Wins are secondary to effort, growth, and teamwork, just as players are asked to give full effort regardless of the score.
- 3. **Positive and Constructive Leadership:** I will coach with enthusiasm, patience, and encouragement, focusing on what players *can* do and how they can improve. Criticism will be specific and encouraging, private when needed, and always followed by a path forward, mirroring the supportive feedback parents are asked to give.
- 4. **Preparation and Professionalism:** I will arrive early, organized, and prepared for every practice and game, with a purposeful plan. I will honor schedules and commitments.
- 5. **Emotional Control and Resilience:** I will remain composed under pressure, modeling the self-control and bounce-back attitude we teach players. I will not argue with officials, opponents, or parents in front of players, and I will address concerns as privately and respectfully as possible.
- 6. **Open and Proactive Communication:** I will keep parents informed with regular updates, clear expectations, and prompt responses, just as parents are asked to communicate concerns directly and respectfully to me. I will host at least one parent meeting per season to align on goals and philosophy.
- 7. **Guardian of the Lightning Culture:** I will embody and enforce the Lightning culture in everything I do: inclusive, competitive, and character-driven.
- 8. **Higher Standard:** I will hold myself to a higher standard than I hold those around me. I will lead with humility, owning my mistakes and learning from them. I will consistently demonstrate discipline, preparation, and positivity.
- 9. **Embrace Accountability**: I welcome and invite full accountability from the St. Louis Lightning Sports Association Board. I will proactively report concerns, accept feedback, and cooperate fully with any review of my conduct, demonstrating the same ownership and transparency I expect from players and parents.
