- 1. **Respect All:** Treat players, coaches, umpires, opponents, and fans with courtesy; disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.
- 2. **Show Sportsmanship:** Win or lose gracefully, congratulate opponents, and shake hands after games.
- 3. **Follow Coaches:** Listen to coaches' instructions on roles and strategies; bring questions or concerns to coaches privately after practices or games.
- 4. **Give Full Effort:** Hustle in practices and games, strive to improve, and never quit.
- 5. Support Team: Encourage teammates, prioritize team goals, and communicate positively.
- 6. Ensure Timely Attendance: Notify coaches of absences/tardiness as soon as possible.
- 7. **No Unsportsmanlike Conduct:** Profanity, taunting, and bullying will not be tolerated.
- 8. Respect Umpires: Accept umpires' calls as final without arguing or complaining.
- 9. Care for Equipment: Don't throw gear in frustration; keep equipment and facilities clean.
- 10. Play Fair: Compete honestly, avoid cheating, and show integrity.
- 11. **Prioritize Safety:** Follow safety rules, report issues, and avoid harmful actions.
- 12. **Represent Positively:** Behave in a way that reflects well on your team, league, and community, including online.
- 13. **Dress Properly:** Players are expected to follow the uniform code for the team.
- 14. Enjoy and Learn: Have fun, learn from mistakes, and contribute to a positive team environment.

# **Parent Code of Conduct for St. Louis Lightning Sports**

This Code of Conduct outlines expectations for parents and guardians of youth in Lightning sports programs to ensure a supportive, respectful, and safe environment. By signing, parents agree to these guidelines.

### **Shared Goals**

- **Support the Team (without coaching):** Cheer for all players in order to foster a positive atmosphere, leaving coaching to the coaches.
- **Model Respect:** Show respect to all to set a positive example for youth.
- **Ensure Safety and Fairness:** Support a safe, fair environment free from disruptive behavior.

### **Rules to Follow**

- 1. **Respect All:** Treat players, coaches, umpires, opponents, and parents with courtesy; bring concerns to coaches respectfully to resolve issues.
- 2. **Promote Sportsmanship:** Cheer positively, and celebrate team efforts; criticizing and booing will not be tolerated.
- 3. **Respect Coaches:** Accept coaches' decisions on roles, playing time, and strategies; bring questions or concerns to coaches privately after practices or games, addressing coaches first before contacting a board member.
- 4. **Encourage Effort:** Support your child and his/her teammates to give their best, focusing on growth and teamwork.

- 6. **Ensure Timely Attendance:** Notify coaches of absences/tardiness as soon as possible.
- 7. **No Unsportsmanlike Conduct:** Profanity, taunting, or arguing with umpires or other parents will not be tolerated.
- 8. **Respect Umpires:** Accept umpires' calls as final; arguing or encouraging challenges will not be tolerated.
- 9. **Uphold Fair Play:** Encourage your child to play by the rules and show integrity.
- 10. Prioritize Safety: Support safety guidelines, report concerns; unsafe actions will not be tolerated.
- 11. **Represent Positively:** Behave in a way that reflects well on the team, league, and community, including on social media; bring concerns to coaches first, as coaches and the organization are committed to kindness, respect, and excellence.
- 12. **Promote Fun and Learning:** Help your child enjoy baseball, learn from mistakes, and contribute positively.
