



Player Code of Conduct

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to ensure a safe and positive environment by instituting a Zero Tolerance Policy. HEO, OWHA, and KDMHA are committed to providing a sport environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity.

It is the intention of this pledge to promote fair play and respect for all participants within KDMHA. Both the player and parent/guardian **MUST** read/sign this pledge before participation in any KDMHA hockey activities.

Code of Conduct Pledge

1. Will remember that hockey is for enjoyment of everyone participating.
2. Follow Hockey Canada’s Fair Ice Policy.
3. Respect the 24-hour Cool Down Period.
4. Will play by the rules of hockey and in the spirit of the game. We agree to resolve conflict without resorting to hostility or violence.
5. Recognize that doing one’s best is as important as winning so that no one will ever feel defeated by the outcome of the game.
6. Will never ridicule or yell at others for making mistakes or losing a game. To respect teammates, parents, opponents, and offer praise for competing fairly and hard.
7. Will remember that winning isn’t everything – that having fun, improving skills, making friends, and being our best are important. WE will acknowledge good plays and performances by both KDMHA’s teams and their opponents.
8. Will never question the official’s judgment or honesty in public. WE recognize officials are being developed in the same manner as players; Coaches are there to help player development.
9. Will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from youth hockey.
10. Will respect and show appreciation for the volunteers who give their time to youth hockey.
11. Will respect the facility you visit or in which you play and leave it clean and in the same way the facility intended it to be.
12. Will not participate in or initiate any bullying, intimidating, harassing, or abusive behavior in any form (i.e. verbal, physical, or through the use of electronic applications such as email, social media, etc.) as we understand it to be unbecoming and harmful behaviour.

WE agree to abide by the principles of the CODE of CONDUCT as set by Hockey Canada and supported by KDMHA. WE also agreed to abide by the rules, regulations, and decisions as set by KDMHA. Failure to abide by this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, suspension, or release from Association membership.
