### **Code of Conduct & Ethics**

The Thunder Bay Women's Soccer Club (TBWSC) is committed to providing women an opportunity to participate in organized soccer in an inclusive and positive environment. Players and Team Officials represent not only themselves, but their team, the League, and the sport of soccer. All Players and Team Officials are expected to conduct themselves with integrity, sportsmanship, and respect on and off the field.

By registering in the TBWSC, you agree to the following:

- Adhere to the Laws of the Game, including TBWSC rules and regulations.
- Display and promote a high standard of behaviour, fair play, and ethical conduct.
- Treat all participants with respect, regardless of their athletic ability, disability, age, race, ethnic origin, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, religion, or any other personal characteristic.
- Refrain from public criticism of participants and game officials.
- Refrain from any violent conduct or behaviour to including but not limited to fighting, spitting, or making verbal threats etc.
- Refrain from the use of profane, insulting, harassing, or otherwise offensive language.
- Respect the dignity of others and recognize that any verbal or physical behaviour that constitutes harassment or abuse is unacceptable.
- Avoid bullying, intimidation and all forms of inappropriate behaviour.
- Refrain from consumption of any recreational drugs or alcohol during TBWSC events.
- Respect the facilities and fields you use.
- Report any violations of this Code of Conduct & Ethics.
