Director of Hockey Development: Evaluator Coordinator

The Director(s) of Hockey Development are responsible for the evaluation process both for coaches and players and are responsible for providing a liaison between the coaches and the Board. The Director(s) of Hockey Development are voting members of the Board and are required to attend regularly scheduled meetings. Duties for each director will be split as follows: Evaluations, Player Development and Coach Mentorship.

The IMHA executive requests that nomination forms be completed for this position three weeks prior to the annual meeting so the qualifications can be reviewed and possibly distributed to the IMHA Executive Board for their review. These Directors are essential to the implementation of our hockey programs and the placement of qualified coaches; therefore a more in-depth selection process is required to find suitable candidates.

Nominees for Director of Hockey Development will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Have excellent interpersonal skills
- Are organized and have proven their ability to communicate effectively
- Have the personal time available to complete the two-year term
- Have an acceptable amount of "hockey knowledge"

Responsibilities:

- Establish the evaluation committee
- Set up the evaluation groups for each division
- Recruit and organize the evaluators for each division
- Assign each player to a team based on the evaluation criteria and oversee the assessment of players and/or over/under age player placements
- Coordinate the re-assessment of any players if required
- Complete the rosters for each team and submit to the Registrar

Term: 2 years – rotating on odd years
