Game Start/End Time

1. Game length 1 hour 40 minutes or 6 innings. No new innings will be started after 1 hour 30 minutes. Any inning started at this time will be played to completion.
2. A game called on darkness or bad weather must have three (3) complete innings or have played 1 hour and 30 minutes to constitute a game. If a game is called off, a new game will be rescheduled if possible.
3. The final game in the playoffs will be 6 innings (No Time limit) unless mercy rules are met.
4. Any players arriving late will be added to the bottom of the lineup.
5. Home team is listed 2nd on the schedule and should sit on the 3rd base side of the field.
6. Teams must have 7 players to start and finish a game or it is considered a forfeit. If both coaches agree, the teams may scrimmage during their allotted game time in the event of a forfeit.

Player Playing Rules

1. 10 players on the field (4 outfield and must be on the grass, 4 infield, pitcher and catcher).
2. All players bat.
3. Pitching mound is 43 feet with a 16 foot pitching circle
4. Bases are 60 feet apart
5. No player sits out more than two (2) innings per game.
6. Each team is allowed 8 runs per inning. A natural third out or touching a base in front of the "8 run" player will stop the inning. The rule applies throughout the entire game.
(During playoffs the 8 run limit is lifted during the final inning as declared by umpire)
7. Game ending mercy rule will be 15 runs after 3 innings or 10 runs after 4 innings.
8. Pitching:
 1. Pitcher can only pitch 4 innings per game
 2. Pitcher must use proper form
 3. Pitcher must wear fielders mask.
9. No leading off. Runner may leave the base when the ball leaves the pitchers hand
 1. Runner can steal any base.

10. **Drop 3^d strike.** Batter is not out if the catcher drops the 3rd strike.
She may attempt to run to 1st base unless base is occupied.
11. Modified infield fly rule: When 1st and 2nd base is occupied and there are less than two outs and fair ball is popped up in the infield, the batter is out. The runners cannot advance, regardless if the ball is caught or not. If runners advance at the conclusion of the play they will be sent back to the base they occupied at the time of the pitch.
12. Batters must bat according to lineup. Any batter taking a pitch out of order will be counted as an automatic out. Unless the batter has left the game due to injury or left the facilities for other reasons.
13. If ball is deemed a dead ball (Stuck in fence or goes under a fence or backstop). The runners are awarded an extra base. (If they are between first and second then they will go to third and so on.).
14.
 - A foul tip can be the third strike, ending the at-bat and resulting in an out.
 - If the catcher fails to catch a foul tip, it's a foul ball, and the batter is not out.

General Rules

1. It is mandatory that players wear helmets with face masks when at bat.
2. Both coaches must meet with the umpire at beginning of the game to mark the time.
3. All coaches must sign a final score sheet with the umpire at the end of the game.
4. No Tobacco
5. No Pets Allowed
6. It will be the responsibility of all coaches, parents and players to make sure the trash is picked up after each game.
7. **Coach's must text Mike Singles after each game with the scores so they can be recorded.**
