

POLICY 19
OFFICIALS / REFEREES POLICY

19.1 Officiating Requirements

- 19.1.1 Once referees are named, they are league officials for the game and are responsible to the Saskatoon Ringette Referees Association.
- 19.1.2 Officials must follow the Ringette Canada Rule Book and the Rules and Regulations of SRA.
- 19.1.3 All referees must attend Officials Clinics and be evaluated each year.
- 19.1.4 Officials are responsible to see that game sheets are properly filled out and signed by both team coaches and by the referees.
- 19.1.5 Referees must wear helmets.

19.2 Officiating Conduct

- 19.2.1 All officials are required to be at the rink at least 15 minutes before game time and on the ice at game time.
- 19.2.2 Officials will treat players and coaches with proper respect and dignity.
- 19.2.3 Officials will determine the length of periods and will inform each team to insure all allotted ice is used.

19.3 Officiating Exhibition Games/Series

- 19.3.1 Teams looking to book referees for out-of-town exhibition games/series must go through the referee assignor to find officials for these games.
- 19.3.2 Game compensation will be at minimum \$30 per game.
- 19.3.3 Compensation for time will be \$0.39 per kilometer (calculation from Saskatoon to location and return). This is regardless of travel arrangement. Teams are responsible for travel arrangements for the officials. If official is using their own vehicle, compensation will be at \$0.60 per kilometer.
- 19.3.4 Per Diem compensation of \$25 per day.
- 19.3.5 Officials will be paid directly from the team with payment being made within 7 days of the event.
