2026 Great Canadian Oil Change U7 Tournament Rules

1. First and foremost, it is all about the kids, so let's make sure they have as much fun as possible! Keep each player to a respectable goal limit. Passing is just as important at this age and we want to keep all athletes encouraged to participate!
2. Games will be cross ice, two games at a time. Teams will share the player benches. Please keep players on benches between shifts or ensure they are supervised if skating in the neutral zone. Ice will be resurfaced after every 2nd game
3. Each game will have two 21 minute straight time periods with 3 minute shifts, with 5 minute warm-up and 2 minute break between periods. No icing or offside. Face-offs to start each period and after each shift change. Half ice must be given after goals.
4. 5 on 5 plus a goalie. Goalies will rotate throughout the game, no goal-tender equipment allowed except for stick. If both teams agree, 4 on 4 is acceptable also.
5. There will be no penalties called but if an infraction occurs, the referee will ask the offending player to go off the ice for the remainder of the shift. It is expected the coach will have the necessary conversation with the player involved. We understand incidental contact may happen, and remember our refs are young and learning as well.

6. One official per game, blue pucks will be used.
7. Fair and equal ice time is designed to ensure that all players get the same opportunity to contribute, regardless of skill or ability. Shortening of the bench in an attempt to win games is not permitted. All players should receive fair and as close to equal as possible ice time.
8. For each game, each team will pick their own MVP and Hustler Award winners. Teams will line up on the blue line after handshakes and awards will be presented.
9. Only players listed on the submitted team rosters will be allowed to participate.
10. Coaches are responsible for their teams conduct on and off the ice. Coaches, players and parents will always act in a sportsmanlike manner.
11. Dressing rooms must be left clean at the end of each game. Also, with limited dressing rooms available and a tight schedule, please try not to arrive at your assigned dressing room more than 30 minutes prior to game start.
12. This is an SHA sanctioned event. Teams must be registered with either SHA or MHA.
