CLASS OF TOURNAMENT: Coed D/E/Rec - 5/5
TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR/UIC: Allie Plachinski/Clint Kerns
HOME RUN RULE: Coed D - 1 and progressive. Coed E - 1 and done, Coed Rec - none. Play up to the higher division.
RUN SPOT: 6 runs per division

RULES:

1. The **travesty run rule** is in effect for **all games**; 20 runs after the third inning, 15 runs after the fourth inning, and 10 runs after the fifth inning.
2. Teams are allowed unlimited pick-ups of players within their own division. Teams are permitted to pick-up one male and one female from upper divisions (Coed B/C) for **one additional run spotted per player**. Teams must have a minimum of nine (9) players for **all** tournament games.
3. Game time is forfeit time. No grace period is permitted, unless the scheduled team(s) is/are still participating in an earlier tournament game.
4. RR games will have a **55 minute** time limit, bracket games will have a **60 minute** time limit. No time limit on the championship or "if" game (travesty rule is still in effect).
5. Batting orders are to be submitted to the home plate umpire before the start of the game.
6. Home team will be determined by a coin flip. In the championship game, the undefeated team is automatically awarded home. Home team is required to keep book.
7. USA Softball of Alaska rules apply except where stated in this profile.
8. Teams are allowed **one** courtesy runner per inning, **per gender**. Any player on the roster may be a courtesy runner. Pitchers may have a courtesy runner at any time that will not count towards the one courtesy runner allowed each inning.
9. The tournament director will furnish game balls. Teams hitting home runs over the fence or foul balls out of the playing field must retrieve the balls or a give a suitable replacement ball immediately to avoid game delays.
10. Protest Committee consists of the Tournament Director, UIC, and a person provided by the Tournament Director.
11. Infield practice and warm-up pitches are not allowed after the first inning.
12. No soft-toss hitting into the fence.
13. No entry fee refunds will be made, unless the entire tournament is rained out.
14. In any eventuality not covered above or below, the decision of the Tournament Director will prevail.
