

DRESSING ROOM SUPERVISION & BEHAVIOUR WAIVER

THIS IS A LEGAL DOCUMENT. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

BY REGISTERING IN THE PROGRAM, YOU AGREE TO THIS DOCUMENT IN FULL AND WAIVE CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS, PLEASE SEEK INDEPENDENT LEGAL ADVICE BEFORE REGISTERING IN THE PROGRAM.

DRESSING ROOM SUPERVISION

Southwest Hockey Association (SHA) endeavours to recruit volunteers (individually a **Volunteer** and collectively **Volunteers**) to provide supervision in dressing rooms before, during, and after all sessions (individually a **Session** and collectively **Sessions**) associated with all supplemental development association programs offered by SHA (individually a **Program** and collectively **Programs**). However, as SHA cannot control Volunteer availability and Volunteer attendance, there is a risk that some, or all, dressing rooms will be unsupervised before, during, and/or after some, or all, Sessions. By registering in a Program, participants and their parents/legal guardians expressly acknowledge and agree that dressing room supervision may not always be available before, during, and after all Sessions and they freely assume all inherent risks, dangers and hazards associated with an unsupervised dressing room (Risks), including but not limited to:

- All manner of emotional or physical injury;
- Death; and
- Property damage or loss, including theft, vandalism or loss of personal property.

DRESSING ROOM BEHAVIOUR

Regardless of whether Volunteers are present in the dressing room, participants and their parents/legal guardians agree to conduct themselves respectfully, responsibly, and safely at all times in the dressing room before, during, and after all Sessions, including but not limited to:

- refraining from any fighting, bullying, harassment, discrimination, vandalism and theft; and
- abiding by all Rules and Regulations of SHA, as revised from time-to-time.

(Code of Conduct)

Participants and their parents/legal guardians expressly acknowledge and agree that SHA may impose sanctions as a result of their non-compliance with the Code of Conduct, particulars of which may include, at SHA's sole discretion, verbal warnings, suspension from one or more sessions, removal from the Program without a refund, and such further and other sanctions that SHA deems appropriate and necessary.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY

In consideration of SHA allowing for participation in a Program, participants and their parents/legal guardians hereby covenant and expressly agree as follows:

1. We fully waive all actions, claims, costs, damages, indemnities and liabilities (collectively **Claims**) that we have or may have against SHA, Hockey Canada, Hockey Alberta and Hockey Calgary, together with their respective officers, directors, employees, Volunteers, members, agents and contractors (collectively **Releasees**), related to (a) the presence or absence of Volunteers in the dressing room before, during, and after Sessions, and (b) our conduct in the dressing room before, during, and after Sessions (**Released Matters**);
2. We forever release and fully discharge the Releasees from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense (collectively **Losses**) that we may suffer, or that my next of kin may suffer, as a result of the Released Matters;
3. We will hold harmless and indemnify the Releasees from and against any and all Claims and Losses, including any Claims and Losses of third parties, related to the Released Matters;
4. We acknowledge and agree that this release and waiver is effective and binding upon our heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, successors, assigns and representatives; and
5. We have not relied on any oral or written representations or statements made by the Releasees other than as herein set forth.
